This is a proposal to create a New Flotilla under Division 18. Some of these steps have already being worked on. At Flotilla 18-6's November Meeting, the Flotilla voted to accept this proposal. We have 3 volunteers to start with. We plan to use this detachment as a shell to recruit new members and eventually create a new flotilla. As I get more information, I'll pass it along. Any assistance would be appreciated.

The detachment will be called Hampton Bays Detachment, Flotilla 18-6. It will be located between Westhampton Beach and Southampton. We will need 3 members to start this off. During 2006, we will undergo an intensive Recruiting Campaign through out the year. Currently scripts are being created for radio, TV, and the local newspapers. These scripts will be used for advertising a series of Open Houses. Using these resources, we hope to attract potential new member candidates thru a series of open houses in different locations within the proposed area for the Flotilla Detachment. We will be directly involved in this project and will attend all meetings. We will continue this campaign until we reach 15 members to break away and form our 5th flotilla. This campaign will continue until our mission is accomplished.

3. Find locations for the Open House – So far we have Hampton Bays Comm Center and Station Shinnecock.

5. Advertising for Open House – Scripts and places for advertising are being worked on.
6. Conduct Open Houses
7. Recruit New Members
8. Find Meeting place for Flotilla Detachment
9. Plan Meetings and Training for Detachment
10. Continue Recruiting
